### **Intuitive Research and Technology Awarded Engineering Contract Supporting Nuclear, Biological Chemical Defense Technologies**

**Huntsville, AL - October 25, 2006** - Intuitive Research and Technology Corporation (*INTUITIVE*) announces the award of an engineering support contract by Edgewood Chemical and Biological Center (ECBC) for research and development services. The contract, awarded 29 September, entitled "Engineering Support Contract for the Rapid Development, Test, and Transition of Nuclear, Biological Chemical (NBC) Defense Technologies" will support ECBC and its customers, Program Executive Offices (PEOs), Project Management Offices (PMOs), and other the U.S. Army Research Development and Engineering Command (RDECOM) functional elements.

The contract will allow our company to expand our support to (RDECOM), Edgewood Chemical and Biological Center across a variety of commodity areas and associated support systems." Two of the ECBC CPE team's top four accomplishments of FY05 included work by *INTUITIVE* on the design and build of an M93 Dust Separator Adapter Kit as well as the feasibility study/construction/delivery of 50 prototype M48A1 and M98 filters with a Toxic Industrial Chemical (TIC) absorbent material.
